Transition Specialist Endorsement Program

Lesley University, in partnership with Perkins School for the Blind, is providing a path to a Transition Specialist Endorsement (TSE). Completers of the program will be eligible for an endorsement from the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE).

Cohort information – 2017

A cohort is beginning January 2017. Using a cohort and hybrid model, each course runs in an 8-week mini semester meeting one weekend per month with an on-line component between the two weekends. The 15-credit program consists of four 3-credit content courses plus three 1-credit field experience courses. The cohort will run from January to August 2017 with classes being held on the Perkins campus in Watertown, MA. Low cost limited housing is available on the Perkins campus during the weekends of classes.
